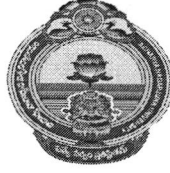

Applications are invited from the eligible candidates for III Semester Examinations (Regular and Supplementary) of M.P.Ed Examinations of Acharya Nagarjuna University for the academic year 2021-2022 will be Commenced from 01-02-2022.

The necessary formats are available for regular and supplementary students separately in the University Website www.anu.ac.in and each College is given separate username and password. So, you are requested to make arrangements to fill data of each student as per the columns given in the format, and send the full galley stating all particulars as per the earlier practice along with the fee details to the University on or before 22-01-2022.

The following is the schedule of dates for the payment of examination fee:

1. Last date for payment of examination fee - 18-01-2022 (Tuesday)
2. Last date with a late fee of Rs.100/- - 19-01-2022 (Wednesday)
3. Last date for submission of galley in triplicate to the University along with soft copy and Hard Copy by the Principals to the C.E.s Office, ANU. - 20-01-2022 (Online Submission)
- 22-01-2022 (Manual Submission)
4. Date of Commencement of III Semester Examinations of M.P.Ed - 01-02-2022
5. Non-Core examination for M.P.Ed III Semester to be held on - 04-02-2022
6. Practical Examinations will be conducted immediately after completion of theory exams and practical marks to be collected through online after completion of theory examinations and internal marks to be collected through online from each college before commencement of theory exams.

All the Principals are requested to collect the examination fee from the students and the said fee shall be paid by way of on-line challan in examination fee A/c No.30908794589 of ANU, one challan for without penalty fee amount to be paid on or before 18-01-2022 and another challan(s) with penalties fee amount to be paid on or before 19-01-2022 and send the galley copies on or before 22-01-2022 along with the list of fee particulars.

P.T.O

The Principals of all affiliated Colleges, ANU area and Special Officer of ANU Campus at Ongole are requested to submit three copies of gallies containing name of the candidate with Parent name, Regd.No., Aadhaar No., appearing subjects with titles, date and amount of fee paid to the Controller of Exams., A.N.U., so as to reach this office on or before 22-01-2022 and requested to submit No-Dues/Affiliation order copy for 2021-22. If submitted after due date, examinations will not be conducted to the students of your college. This is for information and prompt action.

The University has introducing online system to collect internal marks from each college before commencement of theory examinations. In this Connection, the principals of all Colleges are requested to upload the Internal Assessment marks of regular students through online in the prescribed format kept in the URL of ANU available up to 10-02-2022 and send the same (hard copy) before commencement of theory examinations to the C.E Office. The Practical External marks to be collected by the Coordinator through online from all College after completion of theory exams and one copy should be sent to Controller of Examinations ANU by the colleges affiliated to ANU.

The hall-tickets shall be issued to the candidates by the Principals only after verifying their eligibility in all respects, and ensure that they are not under disqualification for suspected malpractice or any of those sorts.

Prior permission will be obtained from the University to the candidate(s), those who are not registered for the previous semester examinations, for Registration/appear for the said Semester examinations.
