Note: All the M.E./M-Tech. (AICTE) I-Sem & III-Sem (Main) Students has to pay an additional amount of Rs. 100/- extra along with their main exam fees for O.U. Aadhaar Based Biometric Attendance System (ABAS) and SMS invoice Charges.		

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS

- The College login will be closed after the last date.
- In case the fee is not remitted to the O.U. A/c. OR if online EAFs are not submitted on or before due date even if fees remitted into fund account within due date. (Late submission of forms by the College beyond the date prescribed attracts penalty @ Rs.1500/- per day and to be borne by the college)
- Principals are requested not to forward/submit the EAF of Not Eligible Candidates. The results of Not Eligible candidates will be cancelled at any stage, if they write the examination.
- The Principals are requested to transfer Consolidated exam fee amount into The Registrar, Examination fee fund, O.U., through online payment in EAF login.

Conditions:-

01. As a part of the Core Banking System, all the students are hereby instructed to deposit the Examination Fee into their respective college accounts only for onward transmission to the University by the college.
02. The II-Semester candidates should enclose Xerox copy of M.E/M.Tech. I-Sem & II-Sem Memo and enclose one extra Pass Port Size photograph to the EAF.

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03. The colleges have to get the clearance letter from (a) the Director, Directorate of Academic Audit, O.U., (b) Convener TS PGECET and (c) No Dues from the Deputy Registrar, Academic Section, O.U. and submit the examination forms through college login. Clearance certificate from Nodal Officer, Statistical Cell, OU.
04. The Principal of Engineering Colleges are requested to collect the examination expenses from each of the I Semester Main & III semester newly admitted lateral entry students @ Rs.300/- per head and remit the consolidated amount to the Registrar, OU together with examination fee and application form in terms of OU Circular No. 3872/D/37/93/Acad., dt.15-12-1993.
05. For the I-Semester candidates should enclose Xerox copy of B.E/B.Tech. and its equivalent Degree Certificate/ Provisional certificates and enclose one extra Pass Port Size photograph.
06. All the Principals are requested to verify the eligibility of the students thoroughly and forward the same to this office for the issue of Hall Ticket. If failed to verify the eligibility of the candidates, the principal will be held responsible for the issue of hall ticket to the non-eligible candidates.
07. **Not to collect the Exam fee from Visually/Physically Challenged and Hearing Impairment students** as per O.U. Order No. 1555/228/2007-08/Budget-V, dated: 25-03-2008. A Xerox copy of medical Certificate confirming their status to be attached. (Minimum percentage of disability must be 40% & above.) **Visually/Physically Challenged and Hearing Impairment students applications forms should be submitted separately along with separate Nominal Roll.**
08. Any discrepancies with regards to the Candidate's data such as Internal marks, Practical etc. should be brought to the notice of concerned officials of Examination Branch and obtain the acknowledgement before declaration of the results. After declaration of the results, queries will not be entertained.
09. The students who have passed their B.E./B.Tech. and its equivalent from other than O.U. will have to pay Rs. 175=00 in addition to examination fee towards Migration fee.
10. **The Principals will be held responsible for any lapse in transfer of amount from the banks to the "Registrar, O.U. Exam Fee Fund Account".**

Examination application forms will not be accepted without fulfilling the above Conditions.
