About TSWRDCs

Thirty (30) Telangana Social Welfare Residential Degree Colleges (TSWRDCs) for Telangana Social Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society (TSWREIS) were commissioned under G.O.Ms.No.20, SCD (RS) Dept, dated 02.06.2016 with the vision to delay early marriages in the rural communities and to empower the rural women with quality education and employment. Within a short span of establishment, Telangana Social Welfare Residential Degree Colleges (RDCs) have created a niche for themselves in the higher education arena of Telangana state with their outstanding achievements in academics, extra-curricular activities and sports.

TSWRDCs currently offers undergraduate level courses in more than 29 subjects including subjects like B.Sc. Data Science, B.Com. Business Analytics, B.Sc Design and Technology, Bachelors in Business Administration, BSc Bioinformatics, BA Public policy and Governance, International Relations, 5 year integrated M.A. Economics, etc. and 5 post graduate courses in Biotechnology, Statistics, Physics, Commerce and English.

TSWRDC is delighted to invite applications for the first batch of B.Sc (Hons) Agriculture (intake - 60) at Telangana Social Welfare Residential Agriculture College, Jagityal from the academic year 2023-24. The course has an intake of 60 and the course fee, affiliated costs are sponsored by the Government of Telangana.

Why choose TSWR Agriculture college for Women, Jagityal?

Eligibility Criteria

- Only WOMEN candidates of Telangana State can apply.
- Parental annual income not exceeding Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One lakh fifty thousand only) for applicants residing in rural areas and Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakh only) for applicants residing in urban areas are eligible.
- The candidate should have passed
 - 2 year Diploma in Agriculture/Diploma in Seed Technology / Diploma in Organic Agriculture from PJTSAU.
 - The candidate must qualify PJTSAU-AGRICET-2023 of Telangana State.

How to apply?

- All eligible candidates can apply on <u>www.tswreis.ac.in</u>
- Payment of Rs.1000/- must be made via the payment gateway before the prescribed deadline for any application to be considered.
- The candidate must upload the necessary documents to verify candidature and the originals of the same will be verified during the counseling process.

Criteria for Selection

- The Selection of the candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in the Telangana state AGRICET-2023
- In case of a tie in ranks obtained by two or more candidates in the Telangana State AGRICET-2023, the marks secured in the optional subjects of the qualifying examination- (Diploma) shall be taken into consideration. In case of further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration and the older candidate shall be given preference.

Age:

The candidates for admission into B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture course shall be required to have completed 17 years of age with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates and 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates as on 31st December of the year of admission.

Residential Certificate:

Applicants who have gap/break in the years of study for reasons other than failure or those who passed the qualifying examination by private study have to submit this certificate issued by the Tahsildar. In case, the applicant has resided in more than one place, separate certificates from the Tahsildar, should be furnished for such places of residence.

Original certificates to be produced at the time of counseling

- SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate, showing the evidence of the Date of Birth.
- Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination).
- Income Certificate for the year 2023-24: The parental annual income not exceeding Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees one lakh fifty thousand only) for candidates residing in rural areas and Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakh only) for candidates residing in urban area (Mandatory document)
- TSAGRICET 2023 Rank card
- Bonafide/Study Certificate from 1st to 12th Class / 6th to Diploma.
- Transfer Certificate of the institute last studied.
- The Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana State in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- The latest Income Certificate valid for the year 2023-24 issued by the competent authority.

Candidates have to upload all the above documents along with online application
