About the Programme

In the contemporary world of rapidly changing global business, which is technology-driven and consumer-oriented, the acumen needed for managers is being revolutionized. Recognizing this, the institute has designed a comprehensive MBA programme. Thus came to light the "School of Management", now known as Department of Management Studies (DoMS), in the precincts of NIT Warangal. The department has an annual intake of 77 students selected on the basis of CAT / MAT/GMAT scores every year. The focus of DoMs is on its premier, 2-year, full-time MBA programme. The course is offered in four semesters. In first year, along with fundamental courses, labs, mandatory non-credit courses are offered to create a holistic learning. After 2nd semester, the students are required to undertake summer training in an organization. In the last semester, the students are required to undertake projects in their chosen area of specialization.



Life at DoMS, NIT Warangal

Life at DoMs is a scintillating journey through education, with a harmonious blend of academic and nonacademic learning that goes beyond the conventional classroom method. Teaching methodology in the department is not governed by any rulebook, but by the emancipation of thought process. The state-of-the-art AC classrooms are equipped with Wi-Fi enabled web architecture and cyber infrastructure, providing access to latest software and statistical packages like IBM SPSS, industry databases like Capitaline Plus and periodically updated electronic journal databases comprising articles of national and international journals. Classroom learning is consolidated by combining "lectures" with real time "case studies" blended with student faculty interactions, student seminars, in-basket exercises, field experiences, presentations and industry interactions with a continuous evaluation pattern.

A great emphasis is also placed on the overall personality development of students to transform them into future leaders. The students, with a great zeal, participate in all the events and also organize academic & cultural activities. Such an eclectic approach to pedagogy unbridles the reigns of traditional thinking to spawn a more holistic line of thought and in turn unleash the latent talents of the students that match the ever-changing competitive landscape in an era of globalization. DoMs focuses on inculcating in its participants a broad spectrum of interests encompassing several real-world issues and an ability to become the "Leaders of Tomorrow". No wonder that our alumni are well placed in reputed organizations in different industries.



Admission into MBA

Eligibility

Any Bachelor's degree with at least 60% aggregate marks or 6.5 CGPA on 10-point scale with a valid CAT/MAT/GMAT score are eligible to apply for the programme.

SC/ST/PwD Candidates with 55% aggregate marks or 6.0 CGPA on 10-point scale and a valid CAT/MAT/GMAT score are eligible to apply for the programme.

Application Fee

- 1. Application fee is Rs. 1600/- for GEN/OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS candidates and Rs. 800/- for SC/ST/PwD candidates.
- 2. Applications are to be submitted online along with legibly scanned copies of necessary certificates and payment receipt.

Admission Methodology

- 1. Admissions are made on ALL INDIA BASIS.
- 2. Selection will be based on a valid CAT/MAT/GMAT score followed by group discussion and personal interview.

All the necessary documents are to be uploaded online.

The proof of payment of registration fee (Rs.1600/- for GEN/GEN-EWS/OBC-NCL and Rs.800/- for SC /ST /PwD candidates) must accompany the application form.



Important Information

- 1. Candidates awaiting the results of the final semester/year may also apply. But they should submit the final marks list on or before 15 September, 2024 in case they are selected. Failing to submit all required certificates before due date, the admission stands cancelled automatically.
- 2. Applications submitted online in any Proforma other than the one provided in the Institute web site (www.nitw.ac.in) or those received after the due date or those, which are incomplete in any respect, will not be considered.
- 3. If two or more candidates obtain the same marks, the aggregate percentage of marks they obtained at the qualifying degree examination, will be the criterion for selection of the candidate. In case of further tie, elder person by age will be given preference.
- 4. Reservations for GEN-EWS, OBC-NCL, SC and ST including PwD will be as per the norms of Government of India
- 5. Applicant should be a citizen of India.
- 6. Admission of foreign nationals, if any, shall be governed by the rules stipulated by the Government of India from time to time.
- 7. The Institute is fully residential and all the students shall be required to reside in the institute hostels.
- 8. Candidates who are provisionally selected for admission will be examined by the Institute Medical Officer and those who fail to satisfy the physical fitness standard prescribed by the Institute will not be admitted.
- 9. Candidate's name will be provisionally included in the Rolls only when the selected candidate reports at the Institute (Online/offline depending on the situation) for admission, submits all the required certificates, in original, found to be medically fit and pay all the fees and deposits prescribed.

Check List

Application must be accompanied by the following documents:

- Scanned copies of Marks Memoranda / Grade Sheets of all the examinations leading to the qualifying degree.
- Scanned copy of Integrated Community Certificate (in the prescribed Proforma) Government of India, if applicable. Please see the certificate formats in the Institute Website.
- Scanned copy of OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS certificate, issued on or after 01-04-2023 where applicable. However, selected candidates are required to produce the OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS certificate issued on or after April 1, 2024
- Scanned copy of Physically Handicapped Certificate, if applicable. Any candidate of the PwD category will only be considered eligible for admission after approval of the Medical Board, duly constituted by the Institute
- Scanned copy of the Degree / Provisional Pass Certificate of the qualifying examination. In case, final result is awaited, provisional pass certificate should be submitted at the time of counseling or before the date given by the Institute, failing which the admission stands cancelled.
- Scanned copy of the Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- Scanned copy of the CAT/MAT/GMAT rank card with valid score or admit card of CAT/MAT/GMAT Exam (in such a case, the candidate must produce the CAT/MAT/GMAT score card during the GD & PI process, if short listed).

- 1. The Institute reserves the right to cancel the admission of any candidate at any stage (even after admission) if any discrepancy is found.
- 2. If the candidate cancels the seat, the amount will be refunded as per the institute rules.
- 3. No employee shall be admitted as a regular full time student of any full time Post—
 Graduate course, unless he/she is relieved of his/her duties by his/her employer and unless a proper relief certificate is produced to that effect.
- 4. If it is found that any of the applicants admitted to the Institute has either furnished wrong information or tampered with the records, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled at any stage.
- 5. If it is detected that a candidate has been admitted due to any mistake committed inadvertently in the processing of the application, the Institute reserves the right to cancel the seat before admission is made final, without payment of any compensation for the inconvenience caused.
- 6. The short-listed candidates' list will be notified in the institute website and <u>no separate call letters</u> shall be sent to the candidates.
- 7. Candidates should note that the **Institute will neither make any allowances** for delays and <u>irregularities in submitting application</u>.
- 8. The Institute reserves the right to cancel the admission of any candidate on the basis of adverse remarks in the Conduct Certificate.
- 9. Wherever doubts or ambiguities arise in the interpretation of Admission Rules, the decision of the Director of this Institute in the matter shall be final.
- 10. The **Director is authorized to take appropriate decision** with regard to any other details of admission not covered by the rules listed above.
- 11.Any legal dispute arising out of this admissions notification is subject to the Courts having jurisdiction over Warangal, Telangana.
- 12. The decision of the Institute in all matters will be final and binding on all the applicants who respond to this admissions notification. No interim correspondence or unsolicited query will be entertained from the applicants in connection with the process of scrutiny/selection including reasons for not being shortlisted for written test/interview.
