1. INTRODUCTION:

Telangana State was formed, as per "Andhra Pradesh State Reorganization Act, 2014 of Government of India; on 02-06-2014. Sri P V Narsimha Rao Telangana State University for Veterinary, Animal and Fishery Sciences (SPVNR TSU VAFS), Rajendranagar, Hyderabad was formed through G.O.Ms. 1 issued by AH, DD and Fisheries Department; Govt. of Telangana State by way of bifurcating Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University, Tirupati. The new University started functioning from the old premises of College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad from 22nd of November 2014 adopting the Statutes of SVVU in totality. Later, it was renamed as P V Narsimha Rao Telangana Veterinary University (PVNRTVU).

The mandate of this University is to strengthen teaching, farmer oriented research and extension activities in Veterinary and allied fields. It imparts instruction in English medium leading to the award of the M.V.Sc. degree in the faculty of Veterinary Science at College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad.

2. Number of seats available for admission:

33 state quota seats (Veterinary Science, Animal Science & Biotechnology streams) are available for regular students and 10 seats for In-service candidates from Department of Animal Husbandry, Telangana State for academic year 2023-24 for admission into M. V. Sc. The In-service candidates who are qualified in ICAR-AIEEA (PG) 2023 may directly apply to the Director, Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Department, Telangana State. The final selection list shall be prepared by the Office of the Director, Veterinary & AH Department, Telangana State and communicate to the University on or before 31.05.2024. The details of seats available in various major fields of study are as shown in Appendix II.

3. Qualifications:

(a) Educational

Candidates seeking admission into MVSc course must have passed the relevant Bachelor's Degree examination from any institution accredited by ICAR/VCI with a minimum OGPA of 6.00 out of 10.00 (5.00 out of 10.00 in case of SC/ST/PH categories).

The candidates from Andhra Pradesh may compete for seats under 15% Un Reserved Quota as per eligibility. Candidates with PG qualification are eligible for admission into

second PG programme but such candidates are not eligible for stipend. Candidates who are already prosecuting M.V.Sc. are eligible to apply for PG admission in another discipline. But stipend paid with interest will be recovered and his/her earlier admission shall stand cancelled irrespective of stage of standing. However such candidates are eligible for stipend in fresh course.

- **(b) Age:** The upper age limit is 40 years as on 01-07-2023 including for the candidates holding ICAR Junior Research Fellowship. For nominees of Animal Husbandry Department, candidate should not have completed 45 years of age as on 01-07-2023.
- **4. Reservation for Local & Non-Local candidates :** Residents of Telangana are eligible for 85 % of the available seats. 15 % of the total seats are earmarked under Un-reserved category and are allotted to candidates hailing from Telangana State and Andhra Pradesh based on merit rank. However, stipend will be paid to the candidates of Telangana state only.

5. Selection:

(a). Selection criteria

Selection of candidates for admission into M. V. Sc. Courses shall be based on ICAR – AIEEA (PG) – 2023 ranks under the streams of Veterinary Science, Animal Science and Animal Biotechnology with independent 100 point roster issued by Govt. of Telangana.

(b). Allocation of seats to PG Courses in different Departments shall be done as per the procedure given below.

- 1. As Number of seats in all departments in each stream put together are small in number, common roster system for all departments in each stream will be followed.
- 2. The seats shall be reserved in favour of SC, ST, BC, as follows: 15% to Scheduled Caste (SC), 10% to Scheduled Tribes (ST), and 29% to Backward Classes (BC). Reservation to BC will be further divided as follows; BC -A 7%, BC -B 10%, BC -C 1%, BC -D 7%, and BC -E 4% and EWS 10% will be over and above the available seats.
- 3. 33 1/3% seats will be reserved for women (in each category i.e. OC, BC, SC, ST) and 3% of seats to differently- abled candidates on horizontal basis.
- 4. 100 points roster issued by the Government of Telangana state from time to time shall be followed for reserving seats in favour of different categories. Separate 100 point rosters for Veterinary, Animal Science and Animal Biotechnology streams of examinations conducted by ICAR- AIEEA (PG) will be followed. This year (2023-24) roster point will start from

- No. 1 for Animal Biotechnology stream, from Point No. 18 for Animal Sciences Stream and from 30 for Veterinary Science Stream
- 5. Top ranker as per merit and eligibility in the concerned stream (Veterinary/Animal Science/Biotechnology) will be called first and he/she will be offered a seat in his chosen discipline as per availability and the same will be continued descending order of the rank.
- 6. Top ranker as per merit and eligibility will be selected against open category to the extent of available OC seats. On completion of OC quota counselling, if 331/3% women have not been selected then the last male candidate(s) required to fulfil 331/3% women quota will be de-selected and filled by eligible women candidates by merit in descending order.
- 7. After filling up all OC seats by merit and also fulfilling 331/3% women quota for OC seats, subsequent candidates will be selected against their respective social category as per merit and eligibility i.e. SC, ST, BC-A to E categories.
- 8. The seats will be allocated to the categories as per the roster prescribed by the Government vide GO Ms No 196, GAD (Ser) Dept, dt: 28.05.2016 and amended from time to time, duly continuing from the previous academic year last cut off point.
- 9. On completion of counseling for a programme, if 331/3% of women are not selected on the total number of seats in each social category (BC-A to E, SC, ST), then the lowest ranking male candidate in that category will be substituted with the next ranking eligible female belonging to that category till the 331/3 % quota is fulfilled.
- 10. In case of more than 01 seat in a category, the decimal point after division of number of seats by 331/3% will be rounded off to next whole number if equal to or more than 0.5.
- 11. In case of a category getting only one seat in a particular year, selection will be done as per merit and eligibility i.e. either Men or Women candidate may get selected, as 1/331/3% is less than 0.5.
- 12. Candidates applying for admission should appear for counselling at their own cost.
- 13. Selected candidates shall have to produce all necessary original certificates including those of educational qualifications, ICAR AIEEA (PG) 2023 hall ticket and rank card, pay the prescribed fee and register the courses at the College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar by the prescribed date. Failure to do so entails forfeiture of claim for the seat.

6. Enclosures to the Google form application:

Candidates shall upload the following certificates along with the application. Documents uploaded to the application shall be of PDF format only and shall not be more than 1 MB size. Candidates shall ensure the legibility of the documents before uploading. The documents which are not clear shall not be considered and candidates will not be called

for the counselling. Candidates shall enclose the designated documents at the respective columns in the application form. Improper filling/ uploading of documents shall be treated as invalid.

- a) Nativity Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- b) Fee payment receipt for an amount of Rs. 800/- in case of SC/ ST/ PH and Rs. 1600/- for all other category candidates may be paid through SBI collect towards Application Fee. The payment may be made by logging into https://www.onlinesbi.com/sbicollect/icollecthome.htm → Telangana → Educational Inst → PVNRTVU (AC Claims), Rajendranagar → Other Fee → M.V.Sc. Application Fee (to be typed). Fee concession is not applicable to the applicants from Non-Telangana i.e. Rs. 1600/- (irrespective of the category).
- c) Transcript obtained at the qualifying (B. V. Sc. & A. H. level) examination or transcript.
- d) Provisional/ Original degree certificates of the qualifying examination.
- e) Study Certificates from the Heads of the Institutions for the study from 6th class to Intermediate II year or Nativity Certificate and a certificate from the employer as the case may be (Vide Appendix). Those who have a break in the years of study for reasons other than failure or those who passed the examination by private study should submit certificates to that effect.
- f) Social and Economic Status Certificates issued by the competent authority of Telangana state in case of candidates belonging to BC/SC/ST/EWS. The admissions given under this quota shall be provisional till the genuineness of the social status claim of the candidate is certified by the respective Departments of the Government.
- g) Date of birth certificate or S.S.C./ Tenth class/ equivalent exam certificate where date of birth is recorded.
- h) Certificate showing the formula for conversion of OGPA/CGPA into marks in respect of candidates who passed their examination from universities other than PVNR TVU, S. V. Veterinary University and A.N.G.R Agricultural University
- i) 10+2 (Intermediate) marks memo
- j) Transfer certificate from the institute last studied

Note: All the originals of the above certificates should be produced at the time of counselling.

- **7.** The candidates who are selected for admission should submit the following certificates/ documents in original at the time of admission in addition to the originals of certificates listed above.
- i) Migration Certificate if the candidate passed qualifying examination from a University other than P.V.Narsimha Rao Telangana Veterinary University.
- ii) Transfer Certificate from the College/Institution where the candidate last studied.
- **8.** If any of the required certificates are not enclosed, the candidature will not be considered for the counselling. The candidates who fail to submit provisional/degree certificate of qualifying examination on or before the date of counselling will not be permitted for counselling.
- **9.** Those already employed including In-service applicants shall submit the No Objection Certificate from their employer.

10. How to apply:

Submit the Google form application https://forms.gle/WsKe5Yy5Uvbede2KA (click this hyperlink for Google form application) along with all necessary enclosures in PDF format ONLY of less than 1MB shall be uploaded on or before 30.05.2024 by 4.00 p.m. Google form applications shall not be accepted after the due date. Candidates who are in employment should upload No Objection certificate from the employer.

11. The list of eligible candidates for Counselling will be displayed on University Website.

12. General

- i. The PG students should not be on the active rolls of employment of Government or University or any other organization (private or public) while fulfilling the minimum residential requirement of the course.
- ii. a. PG students should not register for any other degree/diploma programme concurrently on regular or part-time basis either in this University or in any other University / Educational Institution.
- b. Those who were withdrawn from M.V.Sc course in PVNR TVU for not maintaining minimum OGPA should seek admission afresh based on ICAR-AIEEA (PG) 2023 rank.
- c. Those who joined M.V.Sc Course in SVVU/PVNR TVU but could not complete the requirement and applying again shall appear based on ICAR-AIEEA (PG) 2023 rank for counselling. However, stipend if any paid earlier shall be recovered in full with interest prior

to admission.

- iii. All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. The admission shall be liable for cancellation without notice at any stage during the period of study if it is found that his/her admission is, in some way repugnant to the rules/ regulations or invalid by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicants or their parents/guardians at the time of admission. Any cancellation of admission shall not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.
- iv. University reserves to itself the right to cancel or vary any of these rules without prior notice.
- v. Based on the ICAR AIEEA (PG), 2023 ranks, a merit list of qualified candidates for three streams i.e. Veterinary Science, Animal science and Animal Biotechnology will be prepared separately and displayed on the University Website.
- vi. Counselling will be conducted for allotment of regular seats only in subjects based on the ICAR AIEEA (PG) 2023 ranks and reservation policy of Government of Telangana. The decision of university is final in this regard.
- vii. The candidates sponsored by Industry are exempted from appearing in entrance test.
- viii. The ICAR quota seats if remain vacant shall be filled by University with fresh candidates belonging to Telangana State, who appeared for entrance test. However, stipend will not be provided to the candidates selected for these seats.
- ix. Only residents of Telangana State are eligible for admission under reserved seats.
- x. The candidates selected during 1st counselling including in-service candidates and candidates with Loss of Pay/ Extraordinary Leave have to admit themselves on date of registration failing which his/ her admission shall stand cancelled.
- xi. Candidates shall visit the University website from time to time for the updates and no personal communication shall be sent to the applicants in this regard.

13. M.V. Sc. Seats offered for candidates sponsored by Industries

- *All Indian nationals are eligible for admission under industry sponsored quota.
- *The sponsoring industry should have been registered with the Government and is active for the last 5 calendar years preceding the year of admission.

*The sponsoring industry must have filed income tax returns for previous 3 financial years.

*The candidate must have put in a minimum of two complete years of service by the time of

notification as evidenced by the Form 16 issued by the sponsoring industry, pay slips, EPF

statements and IT returns for the relevant period.

*The candidate should seek admission in the discipline relevant to the sponsoring industry

activities only.

*The fee for the sponsoring candidate shall be borne by the sponsoring industry and it shall

be Rs. 80,000/- per semester in addition to the regular fee. Each industry can sponsor only

one candidate.

*The candidate is exempted from taking the entrance examination. However the other

eligible criteria will remain same.

*The candidate shall not be eligible for any kind of financial assistance from University.

* The Sponsored candidates shall submit the Google form application

*2 (Two) M. V. Sc. seats over and above the regular seats are allotted for candidates

sponsored by Industry in all the PG disciplines put together.

APPENDIX -I

Reservation of seats in favour of Local/Non Local candidates

(In accordance with the erstwhile A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions) Order,1974)

- **A.** (i) 15% of the seats are referred as Un-reserved and are filled with overall merit from candidates of Telangana State and from Andhra pradesh. Remaining 85% of the seats are termed as Reserved Seats and are filled by natives of Telangana State only.
- (ii) While determining the number of seats to be reserved in favour of the local candidates under sub para (i) any fraction of a seat shall be counted as one provided that there shall be at least one unreserved seat.

Local Candidates

- 1. A candidate for admission to any course of study shall be regarded as a local candidate: If he/she has studied in an educational institution or educational institutions in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or, first appeared in relevant qualifying examination as the case may be.
- 2. A candidate for admission to any course of study who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub paragraph (i) in relation to any local area shall:
- a) If he has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:
- i) Such local area where he has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years;

OR

ii) Where the periods of his study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he has studied last in such equal periods:

OR

b) If, during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in the educational institutions in any local area, but has resided in the state during the whole of the said period of seven years, be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:

i) Such local area where he has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years;

OR

ii) Where the periods of his residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he has resided last in such equal periods.

Explanation: For the purpose of this paragraph.

- i) "Educational institution" means a University or any educational institution recognized by the state Government or a University or other competent authority:
- ii) "Relevant qualifying examination" in relation to admission to any
- iii) course of study, means a pass in the examination which is minimum educational qualification for admission to such course of study:
- iv) In reckoning the consecutive academic years during which a candidate has studied, any period of interruption of his study by reason of his failure to pass any examination shall be disregarded. Any period of his study in a State-wide University or a State-wide Educational Institution shall also be disregarded:
- v) The question whether any candidate for admission to any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his parent or other guardian.

Local Area: The Telangana State comprising the erstwhile 10 districts i.e. Adilabad, Hyderabad, Karimnagar, Khammam, Mahaboobnagar, Medak, Nalgonda, Nizambad, Ranga Reddy and Warangal shall be regarded as the local area.

- **B.** The following categories of candidates will be considered against the 15% of the available seats left unreserved.
- a) All candidates belonging to different local areas of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana States.
- b) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for ten years excluding period of employment outside the State;

- c) Candidates whose parents are employed by the State or Central Government / Public Sector/ Corporations/ Local Bodies/Universities and similar other Quasi-Government Institutions within the State.
- d) Candidates who are spouse of those employed by the State or Central Government/Public Sector/ Corporations/ Local Bodies/ Universities and similar other Quasi –Government Institutions within the state.
- e) Candidates who are employed by the State, Central Government Undertakings/ Public Institutions within the state.

Note:

- State means Telangana State.
- In case of candidates who passed B. V. Sc. & A.H. from PVNRTVU/Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University /A.N.G.R. Agricultural University only the period of study prior to joining the University will be reckoned for determining the Local/ Non-local status of the candidate.
