## **PROSPECTUS**

## 1. INTRODUCTION:

Telangana State was formed, as per “Andhra Pradesh State Reorganization Act 2014 of Government of India; on 02-06-2014. Sri P V Narsimha Rao Telangana State University For Veterinary, Animal and Fishery Sciences (SPVNR TSU VAFS), Rajendranagar, Hyderabad was formed through GO Ms. 1 issued by AH, DD and Fisheries Department; Govt. of Telangana State by way of bifurcating Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University, Tirupati. The new University started functioning from the old premises of College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad from 22<sup>nd</sup> of November 2014 adopting the Statutes of SVVU in totality. Later it was renamed as P V Narsimha Rao Telangana Veterinary University (PVNR TVU). The mandate of this University is to impart teaching, conduct farmer oriented research and extension activities in Veterinary and allied fields.

## 2. Number of seats available for admission:

09 seats are available for regular students for academic year 2023-24 for admission into PhD. The details of seats available for fresh candidates for admission into Ph. D course in various major fields of study are as shown in APPENDIX -I.

## 3. Qualifications:

(A) Master of Veterinary Science or an equivalent examination in Veterinary Science from PVNR TVU/SVVU/ APAU/ ANGRAU or from an institution accredited by ICAR in the concerned field of specialization with at least 70% marks in aggregate under traditional system of examination or an OGPA of 2.7 or above in 4.00 point scale or OGPA of 6.50 or above in 10.00 point scale in grade point system. In case of SC, ST and PH candidates, minimum of 60% aggregate marks under traditional system in Master of Veterinary Science or OGPA of 2.5 out of 4.00 or 6.00 out of 10.00 under 10 point scale is essential. The basic undergraduate degree in B. V. Sc. /B. V. Sc & A. H. is essential. **The candidates awaiting final thesis viva-voce result may also apply. But they have to produce provisional degree certificate on or before the date of counselling failing which they shall not be allowed for counselling.**

(B) **Age:** The upper age limit is 50 years as on 01-07-2023 for all the candidates including ICAR senior research fellowship holders.

**4. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:** The selection will be based on ICAR – AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.) – 2023 ranks in respective departments.

**In-service/ Fresh candidates belonging to other states shall be treated as fresh candidates. However, they will not be eligible for stipend.**

**5. SELECTION PROCEDURE:**

Selection of candidates for admission to Ph. D. courses shall be made by a Counselling Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor. The candidates who are eligible for admission in to the course should appear for Counselling before the counselling committee at Administrative building, PVNRTVU, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad at their own expenses.

**6. ALLOCATION OF SEATS**

1. As number of seats in all departments put together are small in number, common roster system for all departments will be followed.

2. The seats shall be reserved in favour of SC, ST, BC as follows: 15% to Scheduled Caste (SC), 10% to Scheduled Tribes (ST) and 29% to Backward Classes (BC).Reservation to BC will be further divided as follows; BC –A 7%, BC-B-10%, BC-C 1%, BC-D 7%, and BC-E 4%. In addition EWS quota of 10% Supernumerary seats will be allotted as per Government of Telangana State roster.

3. A 100 point roster issued by the Government from time to time shall be followed for reserving seats in favour of SC, ST, BC and OC. For the academic year 2023-24 roster will be followed from roster No. 37. This academic year 2023-24 there are 09 seats for PhD admission. Hence, roster No. 37 to 45 will be used for this academic year.

4. Allocation of departments through counselling: The top ranker will be called for first and department will be allotted and roster point meant for OC-General will be ticked (considered as filled up).

5. The 33 1/3% will be reserved for women (in each category i.e. OC, BC, SC & ST) and 3% of seats to differently- abled candidates on horizontal basis.

6. Candidates applying for admission should appear for counselling at their own cost.

7. Selected candidates shall have to produce all necessary original certificates including those of educational qualifications, ICAR – AICE (JRF/SRF) 2023 hall ticket and rank card, pay the prescribed fee and register the courses at the College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar by the prescribed date. Failure to do so entails forfeiture of claim for the seat.

## **7. Enclosures to the Google form application:**

Candidates shall upload the following certificates along with the application. Documents uploaded along with the application shall be of PDF format only and shall not be more than 1 MB size. Candidates shall ensure the legibility of the documents before uploading. The documents which are not clear shall not be considered and candidates will not be called for the counselling. Candidates shall enclose the designated documents at the respective columns in the application form. Improper filling/ uploading of documents shall be treated as invalid.

The candidates should submit copies of the following certificates along with the **ONLINE** application.

- a.** Nativity Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- b.** ICAR – AICE – JRF / SRF (Ph.D.) 2023 hall ticket and rank card.
- c.** Memoranda of Marks/ Transcript obtained by the candidates at B. V. Sc. & A.H and M. V. Sc. level examinations.
- d.** Provisional/Original Degree certificates of the above examinations.
- e.** SSC/equivalent Certificate
- f.** Candidates belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes should enclose Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana state. Candidates seeking of EWS quota shall enclose the certificate to this effect issued by the competent authority. The admission given under these categories shall be provisional till the genuineness of the Social Status claims of the candidates are certified by the respective Departments of the Government.
- g.** Differently abled persons should submit the PH certificate, issued by competent authority.
- h.** Study certificates from Heads of recognized educational institutions from VI class onwards. Those who appeared for any examination by private study should enclose residence certificate for that period.
- i.** Certificate showing the formula for conversion of OGPA/CGPA into marks in respect of candidates who passed their examination from Universities other than A.P. Agricultural University / ANGRAU / SVVU / PVNR TVU.

An amount of Rs. 800/- in case of SC/ ST/ PH and Rs. 1600/- for all other category candidates may be paid through SBI collect towards Application Fee. The payment may be made by logging into <https://www.onlinesbi.com/sbicollect/icollecthome.htm>→Telangana

→ Educational Inst. → PVNRTVU (AC Claims)→Other Fee → PhD application Fee (to be typed). Copy of the acknowledgement slip for payment is to be enclosed.

There is no concession in application fee for Non-Telangana applicants irrespective of their category. All the originals of the above certificates should be produced at the time of counselling and submitted to the college at the time of admission.

**j.** Any valid government ID proof.

**Note: All the originals of the above certificates should be produced at the time of counselling.**

**k.** Migration Certificate if the candidate passed qualifying examination from a University other than P.V. Narsimha Rao Telangana Veterinary University.

**l.** Transfer Certificate from the College/Institution where the candidate last studied.

**8.** If any of the required certificates are not produced by the applicants on or before the date of counselling, they will not be permitted for counselling.

#### **9. How to apply:**

Submit the Google form application <https://forms.gle/cvvZWkcNospBwVLX8> (click this hyperlink for Google form application) along with all necessary enclosures in PDF format ONLY of less than 1MB shall be uploaded on or before **30.05.2024 by 4.00 p.m.** Google form Applications shall not be accepted after the due date. Candidates who are in employment should upload No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the employer.

**10.** The list of eligible candidates for counselling will be displayed on University Website

#### **11. General**

I. All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. They shall be liable for cancellation at any stage during the study of the students, if it is found that admission is contrary to the rules or invalid by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by applicants or their parents/guardians at the time of admission. Any cancellation of admission shall not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.

II. Ph.D students should not be on the active rolls of employment of Government or University or any other organization (private or public) during the period of fulfilling the minimum residential requirements for the course.

- III. **a.** The candidates should not register for any other degree/diploma programme and continue the studies concurrently on regular or part-time basis either in this University or in any other University/ Educational Institution during the period of fulfilling minimum residential requirements.
- b.** Those who were withdrawn from Ph.D courses in PVNR TVU for not maintaining minimum OGPA and again applying should apply afresh based on ICAR/AICE-JRF/SRF - 2023 rank and appear for the counselling and seek admission afresh.
- c.** Those students who joined Ph.D. courses in PVNR TVU but could not complete the degree shall apply based on ICAR/AICE-JRF/SRF - 2023 rank and appear for the counselling. However, the stipend, if any, paid earlier, shall be recovered in full with interest before admission.
- d.** Those of the students who have already completed Ph.D. in one discipline and applying for admission in a different discipline shall not be considered for admission.
- IV. The University reserves the right to modify or cancel any of these rules without prior notice.

## APPENDIX

### **Reservation of seats in favour of Local/ Non Local candidates**

(Vide erstwhile A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions) Order, 1974 as amended from time to time)

**A. (i)** Admissions to 85% of the seats in each major field of study after excluding those reserved for the candidates from outside the State, shall be reserved in favour of and the allocated among the local candidates in relation to the local area in respect of the Osmania University.

**(ii)** While determining the number of seats to be reserved in favour of the local candidates under Sub- para (i) any fraction of a seat shall be counted as one provided that there shall be at least one unreserved seat.

**(iii)** While allocating under Sub-para(i) the reserved seats among the local candidates in relation to the different local areas, fraction of a seat shall be adjusted by counting the greatest fraction as one and if necessary also the greater of the remaining fractions as another, and where the fraction to be so counted cannot be selected by reason of the fractions being equal. The selection shall be by lot, provided that there shall be at least one seat allocated for the local candidates in respect of each local area.

**(iv)** If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill any seat reserved or allocated in favour of a local candidate in respect of local area, such seat shall be filled as if it had not been reserved.

### **Local Candidates**

**1.** A candidate for admission to any course of study shall be regarded as a local candidate in relation to a local area:

**a)** If he has studied in an educational institution or educational institutions in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared, or as the case may be, first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination.

OR

**b)** Where, during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in any educational institution, if he has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination in which he appeared or, as the case may be first appeared.

**2.** A candidate for admission to any course of study who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub paragraph (i) in relation to any local area shall:

a) If he has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:

i) Such local area where he has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years

**OR**

ii) Where the periods of his study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he has studied last in such equal periods

b) If, during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in the educational institutions in any local area, but has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of seven years, be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:

i) Such local area where he has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years

**OR**

ii) Where the periods of his study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he has resided last in such equal periods

**Explanations:** For the purpose of this paragraph.

i) “Educational institution” means a University or any educational institution recognized by the State Government or a University or other competent authority.

ii) “Relevant qualifying examination” in relation to admission to any course of study, means a pass in the examination which is minimum educational qualification for admission to such course of study:

iii) In reckoning the consecutive academic years during which a candidate has studied, any period of interruption of his study by reason of his failure to pass any examination shall be disregarded. Any period of his study in a State wide University or a State-wide Educational Institution shall also be disregarded

iv) The question whether any candidate for admission to any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his parent or other guardian.



**B.** The following categories of candidates will be considered against the 15% of the available seats left **unreserved**.

- a) All candidates belonging to different local areas (AU, OU, SVU) indicated above.
- b) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the State.
- c) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector, Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and similar other Quasi Governments Institutions within the State.
- d) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the state or Central Government, Public Sector, Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and similar other Quasi-Government Institutions with in the state.
- e) Candidates who are employees in the State, Central Government undertakings, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar Quasi-public Institutions with in the state.

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**Note:**

- State means Telangana
- If the number of available seats does not exceed 3 in a major field the provisions relating to reservation in favour of local candidates shall not apply.
- In the case of candidates who passed their B.V.Sc degree from A.P. Agricultural University/ANGRAU/SVVU / PVNR TVU (state wide University) only the period of study prior to joining the University will be reckoned for determining the Local/non-local status of the candidate.
