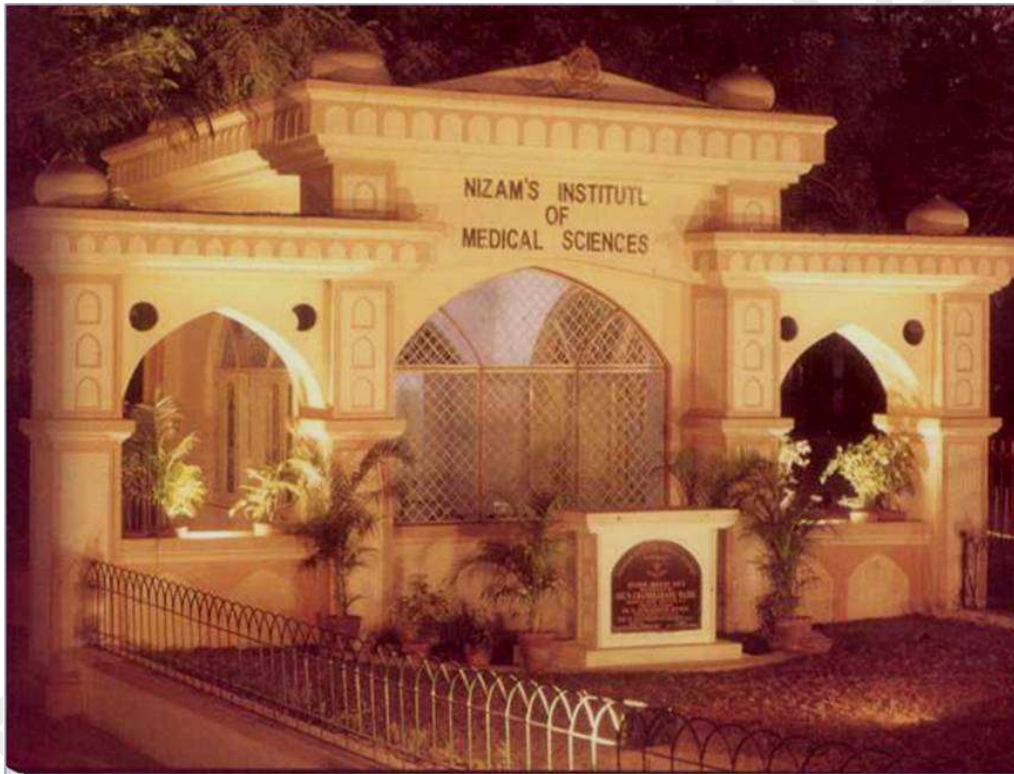

I. Notification

Applications are invited from eligible candidates of **Telangana State only** for admission into Para-Medical Post Graduate Diploma in Nuclear Medicine Technology Course for the year 2024.

II. Number of seats , duration of course and entry qualification required:

Name of the Course	Duration	Entry Qualification	Seats
PG Diploma in Nuclear Medicine Technology	Two years	B.Sc. (in any Science subjects/ Life Sciences)	08

AGE: The minimum age for admission shall be 20 years completed and should not be more than 35 years as on 31st December, 2024. Upper age limit is relaxable by 3 years in the case of SC & ST candidates.

III. Statutory Reservations for SCs, STs, & BCs

a) Rule of reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward class candidates i.e. 15%, 10% and 29% respectively will be followed by taking the total number of seats. The seats reserved for the candidates belonging to the Backward Classes shall be allocated among the five group of backward classes as shown below:

- i. Group 'A' - 7%
- ii. Group 'B' - 10%
- iii. Group 'C' - 1%
- iv. Group 'D' - 7%
- v. Group 'E' - 4%

b) Candidates claiming reservations under SC/ST/BC categories shall submit a permanent social status certificate issued by the competent authority of Government of Telangana as per the format prescribed at Annexure V.

c) BC-E reservation: There shall be 4% reservation under BC-E as per memo No.19392/A2/2007 dated 29-11-2007. The BC-E certificate based on G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare (C2), dated 7th July, 2007 should be obtained from Tahsildar/Mandal Revenue Officer on or after 7th July, 2007. Admission under BC-E category is subject to condition of further orders issued either by the Government of Telangana or Hon'ble High Court for the State of Telangana or Hon'ble Supreme Court of India or any other competent authority.

NOTE:

i. The seats reserved for scheduled Tribes shall be made available to Scheduled Castes and Vice-versa, if qualified candidates are not available in the category.

If qualified candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes communities are not available the left over seats reserved for them shall be treated as unreserved seats and shall be filled by the qualified candidates of General pool.

ii. If qualified candidates belonging to Backward class of a particular group are not available, the leftover seats shall be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Backward classes are not available

to fill up the seats reserved for them, the left over seats shall be treated as unreserved and shall be filled up with qualified candidates of General pool.

IV. Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs):

There shall be 10% reservation provided for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) over and above the annually permitted number of seats.

Persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservations for SCs, STs and BCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs.8.00 lakhs (Rupees eight lakhs only) are to be identified as EWSs for the benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.

Also persons whose family own or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWSs, irrespective of the family income:

- a) 5 acres of Agricultural Land and above
- b) Residential flat of 1000 sq.ft and above
- c) Residential plot of 100 sq.yards and above in notified municipalities
- d) Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying land or property holding test to determine EWS status. The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation. His/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a competent authority. The income and asset certificate issued by any one of the following authorities shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as belonging to EWS:

- a) District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Mandal Revenue Officer.
- b) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar and
- c) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.

The Officer who issues the certificate would do the same after carefully verifying all relevant documents following due process.

V. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS IN RESPECT OF CANDIDATES WHO ARE DOMICILE OF TELANGANA:

The candidates who fulfill the following criteria are eligible for admission into PGD(NMT) course.

- a) A candidate for admission into PGD(NMT) course under "competent Authority Quota" in Telangana should be Indian Nationals/Person of Indian Origin (PIO)/Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) card holder and shall fulfill the following provisions as per G.O.Ms.No.33 dated 19-07-2024 issued by Health, Medical & Family Welfare (C1) Dept., Government of Telangana:

i) If the candidate has studied in educational institutions in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination.

OR

ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared, or as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in any educational institutions, if he/she has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

iii) Local area herein means the State of Telangana. Further, in case the candidate has not studied in any educational institution and has resided in the local area as stated at (ii) above, to be eligible for admission into PGD(NMT) course under 'Competent Authority Quota', the candidate should have appeared for the relevant qualifying examination in the State of Telangana.

Important Note: Candidates who are domiciles of other States are not eligible.

VI. Application Procedure:

1. The Online application registration, Notification and instructions to fill the application is available at NIMS website: www.nims.edu.in (or) <https://www.nimsts.edu.in/Recruitment/hr/pisrecruitment/RecruitmentApplicationDeskAction.cnt> from 11.00 AM on 19-08-2024 till 5.00 PM of **02-09-2024** and last date for submission of hardcopy of application is 05-09-2024.

Note: The candidates are advised to read carefully the prospectus/instructions before proceeding to fill the application form in NIMS website: www.nims.edu.in

2. Incomplete online and hand-written application forms are liable to be rejected.

3. **The registration and processing fee Rs.5,000/- (Bank Transaction charges extra) for OC and BC candidates and Rs.4,000/- (Bank Transaction charges extra) for SC/ST candidates should be remitted through payment gateway using UPI or Credit Card or Debit Card issued by the banks in India or through Internet banking. Application fee is not refundable even if the application is summarily rejected.**

4. The hard copy duly signed of the online application by the candidate shall be submitted in person or by Indian post to The Associate Dean, Academic-2, 2nd floor, Old OPD Block, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad 500 082 on or before 5.00 PM of 05-09-2024 along with all the documents mentioned in annexure-I .

5. The online application shall not be considered without submission of hard copy of application duly signed along with required documents/certificates as prescribed. No further correspondence shall be made in this matter.
6. The applications received after the prescribed date and time shall not be considered. The Institute will not be responsible for non-receipt of application or delay in postal transit.
7. An acknowledgement will be sent to the respective candidate by sms / e-mail or to the login account after receipt of the hard copy of Application. Those who have not received acknowledgement of the application shall contact in the office of Associate Dean, Academic 2 Section (Phone No.040-23489189) within one week from the date of submission of hard copy of application. No further correspondence shall be entertained in this matter after prescribed period.
8. All candidates who are employees in the State of Telangana and Central Government under takings, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-public institutions should submit their hard copy of the applications along with No Objection Certificate from the appointing authority. The selected candidates should submit relieving order along with original certificates at the time of admission.
9. Any candidate of reserved category, if at all, failed to submit the certificate of social status along with application, his/her candidature will be assumed as Open Category (OC).

VII. ENTRANCE TEST:

1. Entrance test shall be conducted at the venue, date and time specified by the Institute in hall ticket.
2. Hall tickets needs to be downloaded from NIMS website while login with registration number and password on the prescribed date. The NIMS is not responsible for non- obtaining web based hall ticket and no correspondence in any other manner will be made in this matter.
3. The selection shall be based on entrance examination consisting of 60 multiple choice questions (MCQs). The duration of the examination will be one hour. The medium of examination is in English. The distribution of the MCQs are as under:

4. The syllabus for entrance test shall be that degree standard of the Universities of Telangana State.
5. The candidates shall qualify themselves therein, by securing 50% marks in case of OCs & BCs and 40% of marks for the candidates belonging to the category of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe.
6. Candidates appearing for entrance test/counselling will not be paid any travelling allowance.
7. Candidates indulging in malpractice during the entrance test will be disqualified and their hall tickets shall be confiscated. The marks of such candidates will not be displayed.
8. All requests for re-evaluation have to be made within the stipulated time along with the copy of the hall-ticket and payment of Rs.1,500/- (Rupees one thousand and five hundred only) by paying cash in the NIMS Cash Counter in person. Request for re-evaluation of the OMR answer sheet of the entrance examination shall not be entertained beyond the time and date as stipulated by the institute. Request for re-evaluation must be submitted to the Associate Dean, Academic-2, 2nd floor, Old OPD Block, NIMS, Hyderabad 500 082.

VIII. Method of Selection

1. Selection will be made based on the performance of the candidates at the entrance test. The statutory reservation rules as prescribed shall be followed and admissions shall be in accordance with G.O.Ms.No.33, dated 19-07-2024 issued by Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Government of Telangana regarding eligibility conditions In respect of candidates who are domicile of Telangana.
2. Candidates shall be ranked in the order of merit based on the marks obtained in the entrance examination. In case of tie, marks obtained in Biological Sciences, in case of further tie, marks obtained in Physical Sciences in the entrance examination shall be taken into consideration. Further tie, candidate elder in age will be placed higher in the merit list.
3. The marks obtained by the candidates in the entrance examination and the names of candidates selected for admission will be displayed at NIMS website: www.nims.edu.in on the date notified. In case the candidate fails to report for admission he/she forfeits the right to admission.
4. The candidates shall have to come for admission on the date notified. Candidates have to report for admission in person with hall-ticket, bond (Annexure-II) and other required documents (Annexure III) as per admission prospectus. Non-attendance to the admission shall render the candidate forfeiting his/her admission. No request for postponing the date of admission or request to appear at an earlier date shall be entertained. In the event a candidate fails to report for the admission at the date and time specified, the seat shall be offered to the next merit candidate as per the admission prospectus.

IX. Admission

1. All those candidates who are selected for admission have to submit all original certificates as prescribed at Annexure III and undergo medical examination. After medical fitness is cleared, the candidate shall be submitted bond as prescribed at Annexure II and pay fee on the date and time specified. Failure to submit the required certificates, bond or pay the fee shall render the candidate forfeit the seat and such seat shall be allotted to the next candidate in the merit list. In case, the candidate is medically unfit at the time of admission, the candidate needs to pay Rs.4,050/- (Rupees four thousand and fifty only) towards medical examination fee. After payment of medical examination fee, the original certificates submitted at the time of admission shall be returned.

2. Fee Structure:

a. Admission fee	- Rs. 5,000/- one time (non refundable)
b. Total Tuition fee	- Rs.17,800/- per annum
c. Examination fee	- Rs. 1,000/- per annum
d. Library fee	- Rs. 1,000/- per annum
e. Security deposit	- Rs. 1,000/- (Refundable at the time of leaving the Institute)

- i. Second year fee should be paid before the commencement of 2nd year classes
- ii. The fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.

3. **ON JOB TRAINING:** All the students have to attend on job training for a period of one year after successful completion of the course on consolidated pay of Rs.32,500/-. After completion of course period, their provisional certificate and custodian certificate only will be issued to the students to register at Telangana State Paramedical Board (TSPMB) and other certificates shall be issued after completion of on job training period.

4. The candidate shall also execute a bond as prescribed at Annexure IV of this prospectus that in the event of not willing to attend on job training after successful completion of their course for a period of one year, he/she shall be bound to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only), till such time their certificates shall be retained with the institute.

5. In all matters relating to selections and admissions, the decision of the Institute shall be final and binding on the candidates and selection cannot be questioned after admissions are closed.

6. All the candidates joining the course shall execute a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) at the time of admission as per the format prescribed at Annexure II on a non-judicial stamped paper of Rs.100/- value along with two sureties (Parents/Guardian) to ensure completion of the prescribed period of training or in default to pay the bond amount and shall also have to refund the amount if any received as stipend up to that date to NIMS. The candidates who resign the course under this clause shall not be considered for any other subject/course during the same academic year. The course imparted prior to resignation shall not be considered for any other purposes.

7. In addition to clause (6) above, in case the candidates attended for the classes after commencement of 2nd year academic session shall also pay tuition and other fee at the time of discontinuation of the course.

8. The original certificates submitted by the candidates shall not be returned to the candidates till they complete their course of study and appear for the final examination. In case, the student requires the certificates pertaining to Degree/PG Diploma course in Nuclear Medicine Technology, he/she has to deposit an amount of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only), the same amount will be returned to the students after return of all certificates.
9. No individual correspondence regarding entrance test/selection/admissions will be made to the candidates. Candidates are requested to follow the instructions/information stated in prospectus at website: www.nims.edu.in as per the scheduled programme.

X. After Admission

1. The student shall maintain strict discipline during the period of study/training programme in terms of conduct rules of the NIMS. Violation of the conduct rules will result in the cancellation of the admission of the candidate apart from invoking the terms and conditions of the bond. The candidate shall not resort to any strikes during period of their study in dereliction of their duties or air their views criticizing the policies of the institute either before the print or electronic media or anywhere.
2. All students shall adhere to be institutional rules and violation of rules will be viewed seriously.
3. The selected candidates shall join the course by the date prescribed. In case the selected candidate does not report by the date, the next candidate in the order of merit will be selected in his/her place. No extension of time will be entertained.
4. The admission stands closed by the prescribed date and the course shall commence from the notified date. Due to unforeseen reasons if a seat falls vacant within the period of closure of admissions, the candidate next in order of merit as per rules will be considered for admission.
5. Institute reserves the right to change the schedule after due notification.
6. The candidate shall not register for any other Degree / Diploma and continue the studies concurrently while doing the present course.
7. All selected candidates must maintain a logbook recording their day to day academic activities, which are to be submitted to the Dean, through proper channel once in six months.
8. The institute shall fix duties and responsibilities of students from time to time. They will be required to pursue such works as may be needed in the legitimate interest of patient care in the hospital.
9. The selection of each student will be subject to medical fitness. The medical fitness will be decided by the Medical Board appointed by the Institute. The decision of the Medical Board shall be final.
10. This is a full time course. The candidate shall be full time student. No student is allowed to do any private practice or consultation. "All the candidates joining the course shall work as 'full time students' during the period of training and shall attend not less than 80% (eighty percent) of the imparted training during each academic year including assignments, assessed full time responsibilities and participation in all facets of the educational process. The candidates shall not be eligible to appear for final examinations till completion of 80% attendance of each year.
11. Candidates found to be ineligible at any stage of examination will not be permitted to appear in the examination. In an unlikely event of any ineligible candidate appearing

and/or being successful in the examination the results/candidate of such candidate shall be cancelled and/or are deemed to be cancelled.

12. The candidates must complete the final examination within a period of 8 (eight) years from the date of admission to the course, failing which the candidate will be required to re-register for course after getting himself/herself selected for the course.
13. Institute is not responsible for any unforeseen events preventing the candidate from reaching for entrance test/admission and the candidate will be considered absent under such circumstances.
14. Any attempt on the part of the candidate to influence directly or indirectly by any means will be treated as disqualification.

XI. Closure of admission

The admissions stand closed by the prescribed date and the course shall commence from the notified date. The duration of the course shall be calculated from the date of commencement of the course without any reference to the date of joining of any individual.

XII. Leave

1. The candidates are eligible for 30 days leave for an academic year they can avail not exceeding 10 days (including public holidays/weekly offs) at a time. If a candidate is absent for more than 20 days without sanction of leave he/she shall be treated as deemed to have discontinued as per the rules. However, a candidate will be eligible for sick leave recommended by the Medical Board constituted by the institute.
2. Women students can avail maternity leave up to 180 days only once in their course of study and the study period will be extended to the extent of Maternity Leave availed. The candidate shall not be eligible to appear in the Institute examination till the completion of study period (Duration of Course).
3. If a candidate absent for more than 30 days without sanction of leave, he/she shall be treated as deemed to have discontinued the course and bond amount shall be recovered.

XIII. Break of Study and Re-admission:

- i) If a student is absent continuously for a period of 91 days or more but less than one year, the student can seek permission for re-admission into the course. Candidate shall apply in the prescribed format by paying requisite fee in favor of "Director, NIMS" payable at Hyderabad and forwarded with the recommendation of the Dean to the Executive Registrar, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences.
- ii) Discontinuation of the course for more than one year will lead to cancellation of the seat and re-admission into the course is not permitted

XIV. Discontinuation of the course

Candidates are permitted to discontinue the course under the following conditions without any penalty.

- i) Illness certified by the Medical Board of the institute.
- ii) Failing in three attempts in any examinations conducted by the institute.

XV. Examinations:

The candidates will have to appear for such examinations as prescribed by the institute from time to time. No student shall be allowed to appear for the examination unless he/she has paid the examination and other fee due payable to the Institute.

XVI. Anti- Ragging Act

Ragging is prohibited as per Act No.26 of 1997 dated 21-08-1997 of Telangana Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997, Medical Council of India (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges/ Institutions) Regulations, 2009 issued vide notification dated 03-08-2009, UGC regulations on Curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 (Under Section 26(1)(g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956) New Delhi-110002 dated 17th June 2009 and amendments made from time to time .If any incident of ragging is brought to the notice of the authorities of the Institute, suitable action will be taken.

Punishment Provisions

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging on campus or off campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

- Debarring from appearing in any sessional test/ university examination or withholding results
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits
- Suspension from the college for a period of one month
- Cancellation of admission
- Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution
- Fine up to twenty-five thousand rupees
- Imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees or with both
- Collective punishment - When the students committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggars.

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would take necessary action as per the guidelines of UGC.

XVII. Sexual Harassment Act:

To provide protection against sexual harassment of women at workplace and for the prevention and Redressal of complaints of sexual harassment and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto under the Act shall be applicable during the course period under the Sexual Harassment of Women at work place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act 2013).

XVIII. Termination of training and dismissal

A candidate admitted to the course shall be liable for dismissal at any time before the completion of the course on account of negligence, failure to attempt to the prescribed studies and duties, insubordination, misconduct or any other offences amounting to moral turpitude on the part of the candidate which in the opinion of the Head of the institute makes it undesirable to continue the candidate in the institute.

XIX. Powers of Dean:

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Dean NIMS may at any time before completion of the course either on his own motion or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks' time from the date of receipt of the show cause notice to submit the written explanation and on personal hearing, order the cancellation of admission to the course. If in his opinion such candidate had furnished incorrect particulars / false information in the application or in the documents attached thereto or in the statement made either before the authority in-charge of admission or the Dean or any other manner. Against any such order of the Dean, the appeal shall lie with the Director, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad.

These rules are subject to change in accordance with the decisions of the Institute taken from time to time.
