- 1) The category and age limit for various posts is specified in the advertisement. However, age relaxation (if any) for Other Backward Class, Persons with Disability and Ex-Serviceman will be applicable as per Central Govt Rules.
- 2) No change in category will be allowed after submission of the online form.
- 3) The upper age limit shall be reckoned on the date of issue of this advertisement. Higher age limit is relaxable at the discretion of the Appointing Authority in the event of persons having higher qualifications / experience.

Mode of selection

- 4) The selection process will consists of two rounds. Round 1 – Skill /Trade Test & Round 2 – Written test.
- 5) Eligible candidates shall be shortlisted and called for skill / trade test. The details of skill/trade test is given in Annexure-A-1,2,3 & 4. Candidates who qualify in the skill/trade test shall be called for a final written test. The number of candidates to be called for written test shall be as per the rules of JNARDDC and decision of the appointing authority will be final.
